

QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS ABOUT WEST HIGH WARRIOR ATHLETICS

What do I need to do to be able to play sports at West High?

Fill out the entire athletic clearance form packet. These are available on our West High Web Site. The packet will only be accepted if all forms are completed. This packet includes:

- Physical exam (Good for 1 calendar year)
- Insurance form (You can use your own or buy insurance from Myers-Stevens)
- Warning of possible injury
- Substance abuse
- Athlete's Code of Ethics (CIF requirement)
- Transportation:

1 student in one activity/team \$110

1 student in 2 or more activities/team \$180

2 students each in one activity/team \$220

2 or more students in three activities/teams \$270

3 students in one activity/team \$270

2 or more students in 2 or more activities/teams \$270

- Parents permission and medical release

What is meant by the term "academic eligibility"?

All 9th grade students are automatically eligible for the first grading period. All other students involved in extracurricular activities must pass at least 4 classes, earn at least a 2.0 GPA ("C" average) and not have more than 1 unsatisfactory citizenship grade every quarter.

How do I get 6th period athletics?

Ninth graders who play a fall sport will be enrolled in 6th period athletics at the beginning of the school year. In the spring, 9th graders who are not in 6th period will be transferred as they make the teams.

How many sports can I play each season?

One per season, which is 3 sports per year. It is an honor to be a 3-sport athlete.

Do freshmen play only on the frosh team?

In most sports yes, but, if an athlete is good enough, he/she can play at a higher level.

How is money raised for each sport?

Each sport receives a limited budget. Since the demise of Bingo, each sport must fund-raise during the season. The Booster Club and Train-To-Win pay for an athletic trainer. Your support in our Booster Club is necessary for our success.
